

Longham River Fishing Regulations

1. Fishing by permit holder only. The permit card should be carried at all times when fishing. Tickets are not transferable.
2. A valid Environmental rod licence is required to fish on the river.
3. Fishing may commence at 7.30am and must cease one hour after sunset.
4. The area to fish is highlighted on the map. Fishing in the works area may be restricted due to on-site work. **FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY REASONS ALL ANGLERS MUST SIGN IN AND OUT OF THE BOOK LOCATED IN THE RECEPTION AREA ADJACENT TO THE ANGLERS TOILET.**
5. Spinning is prohibited. Any salmon or sea trout must be returned to the river immediately.
6. Fishing is not permitted from the island, the wooden footbridge or the plinth on the section of river containing the weirs.
7. All anglers' vehicles are to be parked in the allocated parking bays marked in the water works marked car park on the map.
8. Please do not leave any litter, use radios or discard any fishing line or tackle.
9. The permit card/receipt should be carried at all times when fishing at Longham.
10. The Company reserves the right to remove this permit if any rules are not observed.
11. Your equipment is your responsibility. Please take care and do not leave it unattended.
12. Fishing is only allowed during the opening times. No pre-baiting permitted.
13. Two rods may be used provided they are properly attended and the angler remains within three metres of them.
14. All fish must be returned to the water. Removal of fish will lead to prosecution under the Theft Act.
15. Live bait only permitted with fish up to six inches and caught on the fishery.
16. Large padded wet unhooking mats to be used.
